**GENERAL:** Triglav Trophy 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications. Participation in the Triglav Trophy 2025 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it.

**EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY**: Triglav Trophy 2025 is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2024/25 for Junior, Novice, Cubs and Chicks categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. **ENTERING THE COMPETITION** Competitors in Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior categories (International competition) must be entered through their Member Federation (it is also open for clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU).

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

Each participant must send to web administrator (http://www.europeancriterium.eu) request for code direct online registration and realize the entry not later (deadline for entries) than March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The entries for the competition will be held via web portal europeancriterimu.eu. Before entry procedure association/club representative need to apply for new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/ Account/Register.

Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR Regulation. Therefore, in the context of Privacy Policy, is require appropriate consent in the applications. Without this, the entries for European Criterium competitions can not possible in the future.

The "Program Content Sheet" for all categories must be returned to the Organizing Committee not later than **March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet will be filled precisely by each Skater in English using terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

#### Only 30 best placed skaters in short program will compete in free skating.

#### MUSIC

After confirming and sending new registration data of selected competitors it is mandatory music the competitors need for their add files with performances. to

The process anticipates that competitor's application is in the pending status first. After confirming there is an option to attach the appropriate music file to competitor's application.

When the file is attached to application the status of competitor's application goes to active status and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of selected competition.

#### Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format. Files must be labelled with the name of the name of the category, segment, name(s) of the competitor and ISU Member abbreviation.

Applicants (representative of club or national skating association) is given the option to the files with music three day before the competition replace starts.

Advanced, Junior and Senior Categories have to attach two music files for valid active status of competitor's application (Short program and Free Skatina program).

Organizers of competitions can download a music file of selected competitor and download a full package of files ordered and grouped by the categories. Competitors must have copy of their's mp3 files on USB key (or any external USB drive).

#### **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:**

All entries (for both competitions) - competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other participants are expected not later than March 30<sup>th</sup> 2025.

#### Entry fee for competition

Entry fee is 95 EUR per skater for the categories Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior. Upon prior agreement, the entry fee can be paid in cash on the day of the competition, in the amount of 100 EUR.

#### Cancellation:

Cancellation of the competitor entry, if any, has to be done till April 3rd 2025 with e-mail to organizer. For any later cancellation the team leader or any representative of Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

#### **Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:**

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. The local organizing committee has the right and obligation to check the personal identification documents of the athletes to determine whether they are allowed to compete, whether they are competing in the right category, etc. Without the documents, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules, Single and Pair Skating 2024 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### JUNIOR WOMEN & MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules, Single and Pair Skating 2024 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules, Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

#### **CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS**

All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.

#### DRAW

Draw for all categories will be performed in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controller in accordance with Rules 512 and 513 at 14:00 hour, Thursday 11th April 2025. Starting order for the free skating of categories Advanced Novices, Juniors and Seniors will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

#### JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Panel of Judges and Technical Panel will be formed by the organizing committee and will include judges from the participating countries on the Competition. Panel of Judges for category Cubs and Chicks will be composed of at least three judges from three different nations.

Panel of Judges for Novice, Junior and Senior will be composed as determined by the relevant ISU Communications.

#### LIABILITY:

In accordance with the ISU Regulations, Rule 119 the Organizer accept no liability for the damage or injuries which any of participants, judges, officials or others may suffer. **AWARDS:** Skaters placed first to third will be awarded medals and diplomas, all the others diplomas, after each event.

#### EXPENSES

Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board and travel expenses only for the confirmed Referees, Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators in the Hotel HIT Alpinea in Kranjska Gora, from dinner on April 8th, until breakfast on April 13th. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Club via Email. The transport from the hotel to the ice rink and back will be provide. Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer.
