SERBIAN COVID 19 RULES EXCERPT (UPDATE: 31.3.2021)

1. HOW TO CROSS THE BORDER¹

All persons who are allowed to enter the territory of the Republic of Serbia must show at the border NEGATIVE PCR test from referenced laboratory made not more than 48 hours (72 in some exceptional cases) prior the entrance.

Some exceptions:

- citizens of Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Northern Macedonia, Montenegro and Hungary
- minors up to 12 years of age, if the parent, guardian or other person accompanying the child has a negative RT-PCR test, if necessary

The test document must be in Latin letters and must content the following data:

- The names as per passport of the person which is tested;
- Name, address and phone of the laboratory;
- Date and time of which the test is done.

Serbian Skating Association will cover the cost of PCR test for the invited members of Technical panels and invited Judges, with the proper invoice/payment confirmation is provided. For athletes and other members of the teams, including Judges entered by their National Federation the costs of the PCR tests are at their own charge.

In the case that the invitation letter should be shown at the border, Serbian Skating Association will issue the necessary invitation for all participants at the event.

2. RULES DURING THE COMPETITION

- Wear mask/face nose protection inside the premises. Only exception is for skaters on the ice;
- Keep 1,5-meter distance from each other;
- Don't come to the competition if you have health issues, even as small as a sore throat or nose cold;
- Please cough and sneeze in your elbow, not your hands;
- Encouraging athletes through shouting is not allowed;
- It is not permitted to throw any items to the ice at any time;
- Use hand Disinfection Gel.
- Currently no audience is allowed for the sport competitions. The Organizer will provide live stream coverage of all the events.

2. PCR TESTING FOR THE RETURN FROM SERBIA

Serbian Skating Association may organize the PCR testing for interested participants (at their own cost) providing that they submit the "PCR and Invitational letter form" at latest on 5.4.2021. The price of PCR test is 18.500 RSD (160 EUR).
