“EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026”





GENERAL: The EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024/2025, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Place of the event: **Via Mazzini 130, Pontebba (UD), Italy.**

The rink is indoor, heated. The size of the rink is 60 m x 30 m.

ENTRIES

Junior and Senior categories competitors (International competition) must be entered through their Member Federation.

All competitors must be entered through their Member Federation. The Entries by name with Program Content Sheet must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) <https://fsk-ors.isu.swisstiming.com> **not later than March 7th, 2026.**

After the ISU Member receives confirmation of the entries from ORS system, competitors must be entered together with their music in the EC web portal – www.europeancriterium.eu.

Before entry procedure in the EC web portal a representative of each federation/club needs to apply for a new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/Account/Register.

If the number of entries registered in an individual category exceeds the capacity of the published preliminary schedule and the competition cannot be held according to the published preliminary schedule, the organizer may limit the number of competitors in the free skating to a maximum of 30 for Juniors.

The number of registered competitors is not limited. After the ISU Member receives confirmation of the entries from the ORS system, they log in a maximum of two competitors per category on the European Criterium entry system with music. Alternatively, they forward the received confirmations from the ORS to their interested clubs, who can then login a maximum of two competitors per category with music on the European Criterium entry system.

Organizer reserves the right to make exceptions and accept additional entries. Each competitor registrant must confirm that the competitor has been validated through the ORS system.

Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to properly protecting personal data in accordance with the EU GDPR Regulation. Therefore, appropriate consent is required during the application process as part of the Privacy Policy. Without this consent, future entries for European Criterium competitions will not be possible.

The "Program Content Sheet" for all categories must be submitted to the Organizing Committee not later than March 7th 2026. It is mandatory that each skater completes the sheet accurately in English, using terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

MUSIC

The participating member is responsible for submitting the Competitor's music after registration data is sent and confirmed.

When a competitor's application is sent it goes to status "pending". After the application is confirmed, it receives an option to attach the appropriate music file with the program of the competitor. When the music file is attached to the application the status goes to "active" and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of the selected competition .

Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format.

The representatives of clubs or National Figure Skating Federations have a possibility to replace the music files of their competitors, three days before the start of the competition. Advanced novice, Juniors and Seniors must attach two music files to receive an "active" status of competitor's application (Short program and Free Skating). Competitors must have a copy of their music mp3 files on a USB stick or any external USB drive.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

All entries (for both competitions) – including competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, and other participants – must be submitted no later than **March 7th, 2026**.

ENTRY FEE FOR COMPETITION

- Junior and Senior: **100 EUR per skater**

Any cancellation of a competitor's entry must be submitted by email to the organizer no later than **MARCH 11th 2026**. For cancellations made after this date, the team leader or a club representative will be required to pay the entry fee.

DRAW

The draw for all categories will be held in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controller in accordance with ISU Rules 512 and 513 at **14:00 on Thursday, March 18, 2026**. The starting order for the Free Skating in Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be in reverse order of the results in the short program.

JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Panel of Judges and the Technical Panel will be appointed by the Organizing Committee and will include judges from the participating countries.

Panel of Judges for Junior and Senior will be composed in accordance with the relevant ISU Communications.

EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators and confirmed Judges at the **HOTEL BELLAVISTA ***** (via Della Sella 143, 33018 Camporosso Val Canale (UD)) from dinner on March 18th until breakfast on March 21st. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Club via E-mail.

Travel expenses will be covered only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

Accommodation and meal expenses for competitors and other team officials will not be covered by the organizer.

AWARDING

The Organizing Committee will provide an award for each competitor. The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honoured.

LIABILITY

According to ISU regulations, the Event Organizer accepts no liability for bodily harm, personal injury and loss of property or damages incurred by any competitor(s) or official(s). Organizer will provide medical emergency assistance during competition.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE
