ARTISTICO GHIACCIO PONTEBBA invites you to the Interclub Figure Skating Competition for categories Chicks, Cubs, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice and Advance Novice part of " WULFENIA CUP 2026 ".



GENERAL:

The EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and meet eligibility requirements under Rule 102. They must also meet the age limit specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

The rink is indoor, heated. The size of the rink is 60 m x 30 m.

EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY

EUROPEAN WULFENIA CUP 2026 is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2025/26 for Advance Novice, Intermediate Novice, Cubs and Chicks categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. The age requirements and the special regulation for the European Criterium Trophy are published on the website of the EC: www.europeancriterium.eu and ISU: www.isu.org/figure-skating/figure-skating-events/figure-skating-calendar.



ENTERING THE CONTEST

All ISU members and clubs, which are members of Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. Entries will be accepted by Member Federations or clubs.

Each federation or club can enter two male and two female athletes for each category. The Organizer reserves the right to make exceptions and to accept additional entries.

Each participant must send a request to the web administrator for a code to make the direct online registration.

Each club may enter 2 competitors in each category (2 males and 2 females). The organizing club takes right to enter more competitors.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

The maximum entries accepted will be approximately 30 in each category.

The entries for the competition must be done via web portal <http://www.europeancriterium.eu> entry not later (deadline for entries) than **March 7th, 2026**. Before entry procedure a representative of each federation/club needs to apply for a new account on <http://www.europeancriterium.eu/Account/Register>.

Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR Regulation. Therefore, in the context of Privacy Policy, is require appropriate consent in the applications. Without this, the entries for European Criterium competitions cannot possible in the future.

MUSIC

The participating member is responsible for submitting the Competitor's music after registration data is sent and confirmed.

When a competitor's application is sent it goes to status "pending". After the application is confirmed, it receives an option to attach the appropriate music file with the program of the competitor. When the music file is attached to the application the status goes to "active" and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of the selected competition.

Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format.

The representatives of clubs or National Figure Skating Federations have a possibility to replace the music files of their competitors, three days before the start of the competition. Advanced novice, Juniors and



Seniors must attach two music files to receive an “active” status of competitor’s application (Short program and Free Skating). Competitors must have a copy of their music mp3 files on a USB stick or any external USB drive

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

All entries (for both competitions) - competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other participants are expected not later than **March 7. 2026**.

ENTRY FEE FOR COMPETITION

When payment is made by bank transfer before the deadline, entry fee is:

- Advanced Novice – **€ 100 per skater**.
- Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Cubs and Chicks – **€ 90 per skater**.

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec
- Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec



INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2009 and younger

Technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE I. GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2011 – 30.6.2013

Technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2013 – 30.6.2014

Technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE II BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2013 – 30.6.2015

Technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE III. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2014 – 30.6.2015

Technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and all respective ISU Communications.

- Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1. 7. 2015–30. 6. 2016

- Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec



CUBS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1. 7. 2016–30. 6. 2017

- Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS BOYS

Age requirements: Cubs Skater is, who was born: 1. 7. 2015–30. 6. 2017

- Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Chicks Skater is, who was born: 1. 7. 2017 and younger.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

General requirements

- ❖ Duration of programs: Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec
- ❖ Singles Girls and Boys for Chicks and Cubs categories: warm-up groups can be maximum up to eight (8) Skaters.
- ❖ Warm up time: for girls and boys 4 minutes.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

A well-balanced Free Skating program for Single Skating boys and girls must contain:

- ❖ Maximum of four (4) jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.
- ❖ There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position and no change of foot. The spin combination with a change of foot must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions and without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Flying entry is allowed. If with change of foot, only one level feature per foot will count. The spin in one position without change of foot must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, must be done in a basic position without any difficult variation



positions and will be called maximum level basic. After the required revolutions it is allowed to execute difficult variations, but these will be ignored by the Technical Panel. Flying entry is not allowed.

- ❖ There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface and including at least one skating movement such as a spiral, spread eagle, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc. If the skating movement is missing, no Level will be given. The Technical Panel will not award Feature 3) Use of body movements for at least 1/3 of the pattern and Feature 4) Two combinations of 3 difficult turns on different feet.

LEVEL EXPLANATIONS

For Chicks and cubs, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted.

Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The following Program Components are judged:

- ❖ Composition
- ❖ Presentation
- ❖ Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67

All other General rules and Technical Requirements are the same as ISU rule for Single Skating Basic Novice - Girls and Boys written in Communication No. 2699.

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS

All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System. The results and any additional information for the event will be published on the websites www.europeancriterium.eu.

DRAW

Electronic drawing of start numbers will be performed in the presence of the referee until 18:00 hour before the day of the competition.

Starting order for the free skating of category Advanced Novice will be in reverse order of the results in the short program.



JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Panel of Judges and Technical Panel will be formed by the organizing committee and will include judges from the participating countries on the Competition.

EXPENSES

Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board only for the confirmed Referees, Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators in the

HOTEL BELLAVISTA *** (via Della Sella 143,33018 Camporosso Val Canale (UD)) from dinner on Marz 18th until breakfast on March 21st. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Club via E-mail.

Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer.

AWARDING

The Organizing Committee will provide award for each competitor.

FINAL AWARDING

At the last event of the European Criterium series the individual winners of the final ranking of each category and the best participants will get a trophy. At least three complete competitions in one season are required to award trophies.

LIABILITY

According to ISU regulations, the Event Organizer accepts no liability for bodily harm, personal injury and loss of property or damages incurred by any competitor(s) or official(s). Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during competition.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The Office of the Organizing Committee will be located on the ice-rink and will be on disposal from Thursday, March 19th until Sunday, March 22nd during the whole event.

ACCOMODATION

All participants except members of Technical Panel and Panel of Judges must cover their accommodation expenses by themselves.
